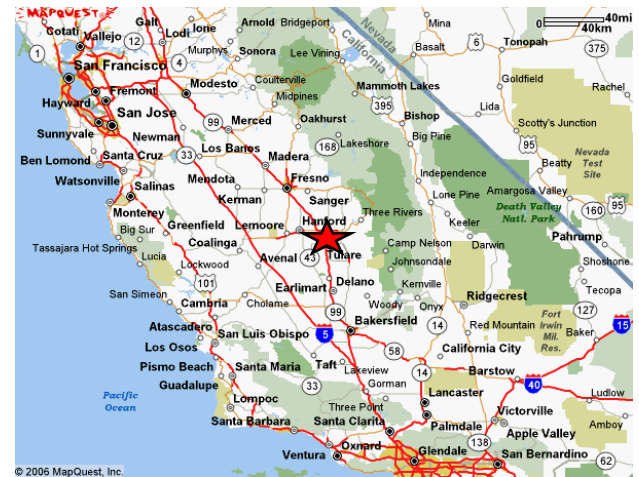

VA Lab training is very traditional & has a few unique features

- Lab has 82 staff (most are medical technologists)
- Main facility is Palo Alto, have 7 outlying facilities that send specimens to main lab.
- Highly automated, with robotic specimen processing and chemistry automation line
- Bench training is 'hands on'
- Weekly reviews with supervisor
- Special lab lectures of interest (new procedures, new lab topics of interest)
- Molecular Pathology 2 week rotation- Viral Load, Genotyping
- Optional – Thurs 1 hour rounds with pathologists, radiologists, medical students
- Reviewing lab findings of autopsy cases. Lab results are discussed and correlated to disease. (discussion only, autopsy not done)
- Each student has own study cubicle & PC in quiet lab library (with view of SF bay!)
- Do not have a stipend, but we have a Work Study program
- Excellent employment opportunities at end of training
- Currently VA has a special new employee program to help pay off school loans if agree to employment for few years
